Statement	Joint Custody, which results in students residing at two different addresses, may be in place as the result of either a court order or a separation agreement custody schedule.
Procedures	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Joint Custody Transportation for regular program students is only considered when both addresses are within the attendance area boundary of the designated school of attendance;2. Joint Custody Transportation for special education program students is only considered when both addresses are within the secondary school attendance area boundary which encompasses the student's primary residential address; and,3. Transportation services will be established only on an alternate weekly schedule on a permanent basis. Service will be established for both addresses providing that the addresses are within the attendance area boundary of the designated school of attendance as defined in #1 and #2 of this procedure, and within the transportation eligible area.
