| Statement | <p>The Manual for School Vehicle Operations produced by the Ministry of Transportation states that firearms or anything of a dangerous nature must not be transported while students are being carried. Some objects could become a projectile on a bus.</p> |
| Procedures | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Skates <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Skate blades shall be covered by guards, tied together and carried in a bag. The skates shall be placed on the floor of the bus at the student's feet; 2. Skis and Poles <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Skis and ski poles may not be transported on a school bus to and from school; 3. Hockey Equipment <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hockey equipment shall not be transported to and from school on a school bus; 4. Musical Instruments <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Musical instruments may be transported if they can be kept safely on a students lap; 5. Skateboards/Scooters/Roller Blades/Heelies <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Skateboards, scooters, roller blades and heelies shall not be transported on a school bus to and from school; 6. Pets <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pets shall not be transported on a school bus (service/guide dogs excepted); 7. Other <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The decision to transport other objects to and from schools shall be determined in advance by the principal and the school bus operator. |
