Statement	Public transit may be used in Mississauga and Brampton to serve grade 9 to 12 students where it makes economic sense to do so.
Procedures	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Students receive public transit tickets to cover their travel to and from school on the scheduled school days; 2. Once a student has been determined eligible for transit tickets, a form must be completed and sent back to transportation (TFL013); 3. Once a student has received his/her tickets, he/she is responsible for them. Lost or stolen tickets will not be replaced by STOPR or by the school. The student and parent/guardian are responsible for covering the cost in this situation to provide transportation to and from school; 4. In the event that a student uses his/her ticket for purposes other than school transportation, he/she must make arrangements for travelling to and from school to cover the expense; and 5. A ticket log is the responsibility of the school.
