## **PRIMARY BUS PROTOCOL CARDS**

**From: Student Transportation of Peel Region (STOPR)**

The enclosed RED cards are to be used as nametags for PM primary (JK, SK, Gr. 1) students at the Dufferin-Peel Catholic District School Board, and the YELLOW cards are to be used as nametags for the PM kindergarten students at the Peel District School Board. If you wish to use stickers or highlighters to identify bus stop locations, please bear in mind that RED and YELLOW are the identifying colours for these student groups, and will remain RED and YELLOW from year to year. Please inform the bus driver of the colour codes, if any, and check every day to ensure that each student's bus tag is visible.

Each school will be responsible for placing identification labels to the front of these ID cards, leaving the Board logos visible. The back of the card outlines the Rules of Safety and Codes of Behaviour on School Bus, which is generic information.

Plastic sleeves to house these ID cards have also been included in this package.

**Tags should be worn daily.** Thank you for your assistance.

**NOTE: It is strongly recommended that the RED AND YELLOW IDENTIFICATION TAGS also be used for Transported AM Kindergarten students who are being returned home at midday.**
